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RE: Business Announcement - Openings available for individuals with I/O waivers

Urbana: Champaign Residential Services, Inc. (CRSI) has openings in its Adult Day Services program for individuals living with mental retardation and/or developmental disabilities (MR/DD) who have Individual Options (I/O) or Level One Waivers. Currently, the agency provides services for twenty-five people in the ICF/MR program and is now expanding its choice of services to Waiver participants.

The CRSI Adult Day services program has two components: recreational and work-related activities. Recreational activities are based on individual desires including but not limited to going to the movies, cooking, playing volleyball, painting and arts and crafts, and community outings. Work-related activities might include janitorial work, vending and commissary operations, small assembly, and lawn and garden activities.

Participants can choose what areas they want to take part in and how many days a week. The program is located at the CRSI corporate headquarters, 1150 Scioto Street in Urbana. Transportation is provided.
