### Insulin Administration ~ 4 hrs.

- Safe handling and disposal of sharps
- Documentation requirements
- Proper storage, care, preparation of insulin to be administered via injection or pump

- Signs and symptoms of hypoglycemia and hyperglycemia and intervention procedures
- Use of commercial packaged glucagons for treatment of hypoglycemia
- Requirements of nursing delegation of subcutaneous insulin injections

### G Tube and J Tube Feeding and Medication Administration ~ 4 hrs.

- Trouble shooting for mechanical problems with tubes
- Complications of G/J tubes
- Emergency measures
- Delegated nursing requirement for G/J tube feeding and medication administration
- Return demonstration
