## THE HOME

This DVD easily addresses fire safety training in any home, licensed or unlicensed. It can be used to train the kids, the elderly or the disabled on fire safety. Anyone interested in proper fire safety measures can use this film for education and training.

## THE CONSUMER

Homes (both licensed and unlicensed) for mentally or physically challenged individuals are particularly vulnerable because of the special needs of people living there. This training tool verbally and visually demonstrates the importance of being aware of the power of fire and what precautions need to be taken by staff and individuals in order to successfully evacuate from their homes.
